





June 30, 2024 HLPOA Membership Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order by president Eric Griffin at 7:02 pm with 17 members signed in.

The pledge of Allegiance was recited and roll call was taken by Secretary Lynda Snyder with all board members present.

The minutes of the May 5 Annual membership meeting were read and approved with a motion by Chris Pheiffer and a 2nd by Henry Jarrett.

President's Report: Eric Grifin

Eric reported that the membership rules and regulations, by-laws and deed restrictions that have been in a review process by the Rules and Regulations Committee and with Dave Brehm and his law firm are finally ready for the board to approve. Once that is complete, edited copies will be available on the website and in the office, and possibly a electronic version that can be emailed out. More on this by the next membership meeting.

Jack K 35 asked if the membership will be able to review the edits of the proposed rules and regulation changes before the board approves. Chris P answered that the changes made were more to make the flow more cohesive and to just generally clean up the language etc. After the board approves the process of updating the rules will be ongoing with the need to implement new rules for everchanging situations and circumstances as they arise.

Vice President: Chris Pheiffer

Chris the board rep for the facilities and maintenance committee reported on last month's progress made by Josh and crew. He highlighted the beautiful new water feature and cement picnic area at the main beach, the newly cleaned up area under the Brass' upper deck facing the cove, new sand at the East Beach along with refiguring the courts and adding sand on the volleyball court at the main beach and the newly rocked shoreline near the disc golf course. He also mentioned that there is still concrete work to do for the golf cart turn lane on Lake Holiday Lane and the cornhole pads on the main beach.

Dave S 571 Asked that the top of the golf cart path be addressed, and Chris answered that it is on the list. Jen B 703 Inquired about signage on SR 162 where the golf carts come off the trail to cross over to the golf course. Chris H will call ODOT and inquire as to what can be done to warn drivers of a golf cart crossing there.

Rose Ann 943 Mentioned that the new marina gate is a great improvement. It now meets the new safety codes. **Anni G 79** Thanked Josh and crew for the newest beach aesthetics and mentioned that a great portion of these were the result of many of our members stepping up and donating labor and supplies....namely Brian Barman, Cody Flew, Dave Homan and Ted Heitsche.

Treasurer's Report: Henry Jarrett

Henry had a cash basis report compared with budget through May 31 available as a hand out. He briefly went over the numbers and mentioned that there was an error in the line item number for Marina Boat Registration and Stickers. 30,000 was budgeted as income when in actuality it should be \$15,000. He will have it corrected by the next meeting. (The numbers were doubled since boats need 2 stickers).

We have \$71,000 budgeted for chip and tar for most of the west side of 99 this year. Process is scheduled to start this coming Monday June 24.

Henry and Josh met with the engineer doing the leg work for the capital reserve study several weeks ago. We are supposed to have a report back sometime in July.

Barb H 912 asked about the Bank Charges/Credit Card Fees Expense line item. Chris P answered that it is merely a pass-through account. We are charged when we run a credit card for a payment, but the charge is passed onto the member using the credit card.

Jack K 35 Aske d about the maintenance equipment expense amount. Chris P answered that it is a cumulative amount for a lot of smaller purchases, not 1 major expense for 1 huge piece of machinery.

Paul Z 1321 Asked about the "doubled' marina sticker income.... If it included golf carts and trailers. YES.

Secretary's Report: Lynda Snyder

Lynda reported that the Social Committee and the Lake Fest Committee have been busy planning our summer FUN events. The 1st on water poker run was held June 15, sold out before the day of the event and was a HUGE success. Winner w/ 4 of a kind (Jacks!!) went home with ½ the pot...so \$650 and the other \$650 will go to the Social Committee for future FUN use! Memorial Day Pancake breakfast was well attended. The next Pancake Breakfast is Saturday July 5. We serve from8-11, the meals are by donation and we are always in need of volunteers to help. 2024 Lake Fest celebrating our lakes 60th Birthday and 60 years of Peace Love and Sandy Toes will take place July 27 with family fun night Friday July 26. Lots of new twists this year to highlight our family oriented 60 yr, old community. Watch for info on Next Door and the website around July 1 with all details. Volunteer opportunities will be available for 2 hour time slots. Please consider volunteering so as to make the event fun for all and to give the "usual volunteers" a chance for a few hours off!

Lisa Stumpf gave an update on the donations collected for the July 5 Fireworks at the lake. Enough donations have been collected to pay for the liability insurance and a good show. She will still gladly accept donations to enhance the show and extend the length of the show.

Jen B 703 asked that the boat parade be extended farther down the south end of the lake. We will advise when we know the number of participants.

Karri W 997 Asked if any of our local politicians had been notified of the Lake's upcoming 60th birthday and invited out to see what our community is all about. Lynda will try to contact the commissioners....

Jane W 1317 announced that The Brass was hosting a large Poker Run on Saturday. We were not informed, but will look into the matter.

Director's Report: Chris Hassmann

Chris talked with Tom Secor, president of the Southern 5 Sewer District. No real updates, the board is in the financial stage to determine costs and funding options.

The Safety Committee is still looking to meet with a local sheriff's deputy to discuss reinstating the Neighborhood Watch Program. Chris will set a time for the meeting in hopes that members will attend.

Chris made a phone call to ODNR after the May Annual Meeting addressing the speed limit in our area on SR 99. Chris was informed by a traffic engineer that studies had been done and our area doesn't meet the criteria for a reduced speed limit or any other warning signs or lights.

Chris also encouraged every member to become familiar with our boating rules, golf cart path rules. Members need to use common sense and be aware. The committee is hoping to be able to post short safety videos specific to our lake on the new website: holidaylakes.org. (The site is a work in process we are working with a member volunteer to get this up and running and are learning more on how to post things etc.

Jack K 35 Reported witnessing several unsafe boating incidents within the last few days. Jet skis racing at top speeds, wake boats traveling way too fast. He reported that there have been 7 deaths on our lake and no one wants to see anymore!

Old Business:

Barb H 912 Asked that old business items remain on the Old Business Agenda until the situations are resolved. Chris P knew exactly what Barb was going to ask about.... The unsafe and rotting posts and high unsightly and view blocking tall weeds on the lake's easement portion of Lakeview Dr. Chris P noted that this job was to be done before Josh's vacation, but there just wasn't enough time. He assured her that the situation would be addressed. Also that the rises in the road on Evergreen Circle would be experimentally grinded down by Josh as with the ones on Robin Lane. Jane W 1317 Asked about the unsightly, unkept house just south of the 99 bridge on the west side right on the water...The dock is deteriorated, hole in the roof etc. Owner has been contacted, but has not done any work. The board will address.

Dave S 578 Mentioned the A frame on Lake Shore that is in a similar situation.... He also asked about trimming trees overhanging the road on Walnut Circle. He asked if he could trim the overhanging branches. YES





HOLIDAY LAKES BOATING SAFETY RULES (plus all Ohio Regulations in OAC 1501)

- *B2. All watercrafts shall keep to the right shoreline or to the right of center buoys where installed. \$250.00 fine
- *B3. All watercrafts must maintain spacing of at least sixty (60) feet between themselves and other watercraft, skiers, surfers, tubers, wake/knee boarders and any other objects on the lake. \$250.00 fine plus any medical or property damage.
- *B4. All watercraft advancing on a skier, surfer, tuber, or wake/knee boarder should not follow less than 90 feet directly behind in the event skier, tuber, or knee boarder falls. \$250 fine plus any medical or property damage.
- *B5. No wake allowed within channels. \$250.00 fine
- *B6. Boaters should not exceed the capacity standards of their watercraft as established by the manufacturer. \$250.00 fine
- *B7. A). All watercrafts must avoid swimming beaches (unless parking in designated beach parking areas) and other designated areas. Watercraft operating within fifty (50) feet of the beaches, swim areas and swim ropes must operate at idle speed. \$250.00 fine
- B). All watercrafts must not exceed the maximum speed of forty (40) miles per hour. If a lesser speed is posted, it must be observed. \$250.00 fine
- *B8. A). All watercraft operating on Holiday Lakes between sundown and sunrise must be equipped with operation lights as required by the Ohio Division of Watercraft. During these hours, watercraft shall operate at idle speed or a speed not greater than five miles per hour. There are red strobe lights located strategically around the lake to serve as a reminder of these idle speed (sunset-sunrise) times. \$250.00 fine
- B). Operation of jet skis (personal watercraft) on the lake between the hours of sunset and sunrise is prohibited. \$250.00 fine **B15.** The following equipment must be present and usable in every Holiday Lakes boat to pass inspection for registration (per Ohio Revised Code Chapter 1547 and 1548) **\$100.00** fine will be levied for each equipment violation:
- A. Life preservers or ski vests easily accessible for each passenger.
- B. Preservers must be always worn by children less than 10 years old while in the boat. (Applies to all watercraft).
- C. Distress flag (orange two' x 2')
- D. Horn
- E. Fire extinguisher (power craft only) easily accessible and ready for operation.
- F. Bow line (minimum of 15 feet)
- G. Anchor and adequate anchor line (power craft only).
- H. Paddle or equivalent
- I. Coast Guard approved running lights after dark.
- J. First aid kit, bailer (plastic bottle or bucket)
- K. All other equipment as required by ODNR rules and regulations.



- *B16. The following water activities are prohibited (NOTE: Fines for B16 rules will be levied against the parents of any violator who is under the age 16.):
- A. Swimming under the platforms in the beach areas. **\$25.00 fine**
- B. Diving off the dam. \$250.00 fine
- C. Swimming across the main lake. \$100.00 fine
- D. Swimming after sunset. \$100.00 fine
- E. Wading or swimming outside the marked swim areas at the beaches. \$100.00 fine
- F. Water skiing, surfing, tubing, wake or knee boarding after sunset. \$250.00 fine
- G. Trespassing on the spillway. \$250.00 fine
- *B17. Swimming should be confined to within 25 feet of the shore except within marked areas.

\$100.00 fine

- *B18. Persons must always wear life vests while skiing, surfing, tubing knee and wake boarding or while on jet skis. \$100.00 fine
- *B19. Watercraft towing skiers, surfers, tubers, knee, or wake boarders are required to have an observer in addition to the watercraft operator in accordance with Ohio laws. \$100.00 fine

(Any structure permanent or semi-permanent that creates an appurtenance in the lake.) No permit required for the following: Roof, Siding, Window/Door replacement. Members will be assessed a \$500 fine if found doing construction on any of the above projects without applying for and obtaining a construction permit and/or posting a performance bond prior to any work being done. Failure to do so will result in a \$200 per month fine assessed to the property owner until all construction has been terminated, removed, and restored. All work must comply with dimensions and set backs of Holiday Lakes Building and R.C.O. Codes. If more than one line item is to be performed at the same time, each permit fee applies. The only exception is a New Home Permit, which includes septic, culvert, and drive. No combining multiple jobs into one permit. If work is started without applying for and receiving permit with approved plans, the permit fee will be doubled, plus \$500 fine.


