As we head into the new season, I'd like to take a moment to thank our maintenance team for their hard work over the winter. Snow removal and winter upkeep are not easy tasks, and their dedication helped keep Holiday Lakes safe and accessible for everyone.

I'd also like to share that we've recently completed some upgrades to the HOA office to improve our workspace and better serve our community.

With spring just around the corner, the maintenance team has been hard at work finishing many winter projects in anticipation of the up-coming summer. Josh, Kyle, Dom, and Ryan (who helped while on winter break from Baldwin Wallace) spent the winter working on many maintenance projects ranging from weir dam cleanout/maintenance to remodeling the HLPOA offices. Some of the specific projects include:

Weir dams were cleaned out and rebuilt where needed to help protect the lake. Locations include:

- Lake Holiday Lane - Main Entrance
- Meadowview Road
- Lakeshore Drive/Lisa Lane
- Timothy Drive

The cove on Greenfield Drive was cleaned out

Several culverts on Meadowview Road and Lakeshore Drive were cleaned out

Tree trimming and brush removal around the lake

HLPOA office remodel project is nearing completion

Winter road maintenance and snow removal

Cleaned out several of the storage areas around the lake for better 2026 usage

Lake equipment maintenance including redecking and updating the electronics on the maintenance pontoon

We would like to thank everyone who has volunteered their time and other generous donations to help in maintaining our lake. I would like to recognize the architectural committee for their continued efforts which are instrumental to ensuring structures, shoreline and property improvements are in compliance with the HLPOA by-laws and building code. The lake would also like to thank members Ted and Stacy Heitsche of Heitsche North Shore Stone Quarry for once again supplying stone for some of the projects completed this winter. Thanks to their generous donation, this has once again helped us to complete projects cost effectively and within budget.
